

## HAZARD INFORMATION FOR TEACHERS GARNHALL: DITCH

This section of the ditch can be accessed from behind the Castlecary House Hotel, east of Castlecary village on the B816. A kissing gate gives access into the field.

It is the responsibility of teachers and group leaders to complete a risk assessment prior to any site visit with a group. This is a requirement of most education authorities. The following information is intended as a preparatory tool and does not replace a teacher's or group leader's own risk assessment.

Please be aware that changes in weather may affect the risks inherent in an outdoor site. Pupils should dress for outdoors.



### POTENTIAL HAZARDS AT GARNHALL

#### PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO SITE

- Risk from moving cars in the car park.
- The field is very muddy, with ditches, a pond and running water. Pupils should be dressed appropriately and supervised at all times.
- There are horses in this field; pupils should be prepared.

#### EXTERNAL HAZARDS

- Trip risk from boulders, tussocks and uneven ground.
