

HAZARD INFORMATION FOR TEACHERS BRIDGENESS: REPLICA DISTANCE SLAB

A replica of this famous distance slab can be seen on Harbour Road, Bo'ness, opposite the entrance to Bridgeness Crescent. On-street parking; plenty of room to assemble around the stone.

It is the responsibility of teachers and group leaders to complete a risk assessment prior to any site visit with a group. This is a requirement of most education authorities. The following information is intended as a preparatory tool and does not replace a teacher's or group leader's own risk assessment.

Please be aware that changes in weather may affect the risks inherent in an outdoor site. Pupils should dress for outdoors.



POTENTIAL HAZARDS AT BRIDGENESS

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO SITE

• Harbour Road is not that busy, but there is no pavement and pupils should take care when approaching the slab.

EXTERNAL HAZARDS

- Low wall with short drop down to park beside slab pupils should take care.
- Paving stones around the slab may become slippery in wet weather.
