

HAZARD INFORMATION FOR TEACHERS NEW KILPATRICK CEMETERY: WALL BASE

Within New Kilpatrick cemetery, Boclair Road, Hillfoot, Bearsden lie two well-preserved stretches of the stone base of the wall. On-street parking is available on Boclair Road.

It is the responsibility of teachers and group leaders to complete a risk assessment prior to any site visit with a group. This is a requirement of most education authorities. The following information is intended as a preparatory tool and does not replace a teacher's or group leader's own risk assessment.

Please be aware that changes in weather may affect the risks inherent in an outdoor site. Pupils should dress for outdoors.



POTENTIAL HAZARDS AT NEW KILPATRICK CEMETERY

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO SITE

- This is a busy road, and pupils must be supervised closely.
- Trip hazard from some fallen grave slabs.
- Possibility of cemetery service vehicles driving along the wide paths.

EXTERNAL HAZARDS

- At the first section of the rampart base there is a steep drop down to the base of the wall and pupils should stand back from the edge.
- Grass may be slippery in wet weather.
