

A section of the ditch can be viewed in Polmont Woods. Access is via Smiddy Brae, a quiet road off the B904 Polmont to Grangemouth Road. There is a small car park just to the east of Millhall Gardens. Three paths lead off from here; the middle one, between wooden fence posts gives quickest access to the ditch.

It is the responsibility of teachers and group leaders to complete a risk assessment prior to any site visit with a group. This is a requirement of most education authorities. The following information is intended as a preparatory tool and does not replace a teacher's or group leader's own risk assessment.

Please be aware that changes in weather may affect the risks inherent in an outdoor site. Pupils should dress for outdoors.

## POTENTIAL HAZARDS AT POLMONT WOODS

## PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO SITE

- Risk from moving cars in the car park.
- The Millhall burn runs close by; pupils should keep well clear.
- The path up to the ditch is steep and loose trip risk.

## EXTERNAL HAZARDS

- Trip risk from fallen branches, uneven surface, boggy ground, boulders etc
- The sides of the ditch are steep and uneven; pupils should take care.
